Directions to the Engineering Quadrangle at Princeton University from points north.

Follow the New Jersey Turnpike South to Exit 9 - New Brunswick.

After exiting, use a toll booth on the far right.

After the toll booth, turn right onto the ramp to Highway 18 North.

Once on Rt. 18, bear left into the middle lane. If you remain in the far right lane, you will find yourself forced to into the northbound entrance to Rt 1. When you pass this entrance, get back into the right lane. You will cross a bridge over Rt. 1. These three turns occur in rapid succession!

Immediately bear right after the bridge for an obscured exit to US 1 south towards Trenton.

Follow US 1 south about 18 miles (29 km).

As you approach the town of Princeton from Route 1, you will pass the exits for Ridge Road and College Road. You will then pass the Scudders Mill Road exit.

Turn right onto the Harrison Street exit (there is a traffic light).

Follow Harrison St. about one mile (1.6 km). You will go over the bridge that spans Lake Carnegie. Drive up the hill.

Go to the second light, Prospect Avenue. Turn left onto Prospect

Go two streets, counting on your right, (Princeton Ave. and Murray Pl.) Turn right onto the access road to the parking garage.

The garage looks rather like a penitentiary; it stands partially behind an impressive brick wall and wrought iron gate. If you are driving along Prospect, and see the gate, you have gone too far.
